Rules & Requirements

- Entrants must be current UTSA students, faculty, or staff.
- Entrants may submit one photo in each category.
- Preference will be given to photos submitted along with a 100-300 word explanation of how your photo illustrates your personal/academic/professional connection abroad.
- Photos must be original work, have been taken abroad and have been taken during an experience related to UTSA, such as study abroad, research abroad, or conference attendance abroad.
- Submitted photos must be of high quality (1MB+).
- Photos must be submitted by end of day on **Tuesday, November 1, 2016** to <u>studyabroad@utsa.edu</u>. Type IEW Photo Contest in the subject line and attach (1) your photos, (2) this PDF document with the Entry Information and signature on page 2 completed electronically, and (3) your essays attached to the email as Word or PDF if you choose to include them.

Judging & Awards

A panel will vote to decide the winning photographs. Prizes will be awarded to the winners in all 3 categories. Winning photos and accompanying essays will be displayed during *International Education Week* (November 14-18, 2016).

<u>Ownership</u>

Photographers retain the copyright of their photographs. However, by entering the contest, photographers agree to have their submitted photograph and accompanying essays displayed at all International Education Week events; on the Education Abroad Services (EAS), the Office of International Programs (OIP), the International Education Week (IEW), and other University websites; and on any other distribution channels without any fee or other form of compensation, and agree that EAS, OIP, IEW, and the University may make and retain copies of the photograph for archival purposes.

Entries (including non-winning entries) may be selected for display or use in other EAS, OIP, IEW and University materials without permission from the photographer. Entries will never be used by any of these units in any manner for sales. In the event that ownership of any photograph submitted to this competition is contested in any manner, EAS, OIP, and IEW retain the discretion to disqualify that photograph and discontinue use of the photograph.
